Lot 17: This **rare metallic silver python CHANEL purse** is a stunning addition to any closet. Its frame top is accented by two silver chain handles and embossed with the label's iconic "CC" monogram. The interior is luxuriously quilted in black satin and features a zip pocket, one slip pocket and one mobile slip pocket. Estimate \$8,000 - \$9,500

Lot 81: Cartier Love Bracelet. A contemporary style designed to be loved for a lifetime from Cartier. The LOVE collection is a symbol of free-spirited love. Its binding closure and screw motif give it true permanence, while diverse interpretations allow for a unique expression of feelings. Lock in your love, forever. The Cartier love bracelet is composed of 18k rose gold. Hallmarked Cartier - make the most out of your next investment piece. Estimate: \$4,500 - \$6,500



Lot 85: Van Cleef & Arpels Vintage White Gold and Diamond Alhambra Earring Studs. Designed in 1968, the Van Cleef & Arpels four-leaf clover inspired the Alhambra jewelry collection and has since become an enduring symbol of luck. These beautiful clover earrings, crafted from 18k white gold and embedded with diamonds, are lovely examples of the House's timeless design. If you want a forever investment piece, this is it. Estimate: \$6,000 - \$9,000

Lot 87: Hermès H Belt Buckle & Reversible Leather Belt. The stylist Catherine Karoly designed this first interchangeable buckle in 1967. It was so successful that people lined up outside the Faubourg store. As a result of its popularity and for its practicality, sales staff ended up naming it after the drawer in which it was stored, No. 5382. Estimate: \$500 - \$800



Lot 50: This Gucci Snow White sweater from the Spring/Summer 2018 collection draws on inspiration from classic cartoons and forgotten childhood memories. It is expertly crafted with delicate light-catching sequins, making it a show-stopping piece that can be worn day or night. Estimate: \$1,800 - \$2,000



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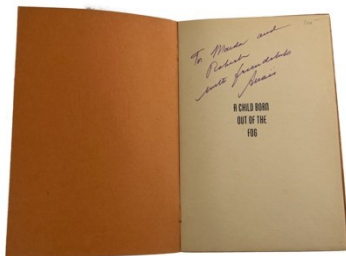
Lot 77: Rare David Yurman Pearl Necklace. These pearls are the ultimate statement piece. This classic, one-of-a-kind piece exalts the luminous beauty of these hand-selected pearls. The necklace comes with original purchase receipt.
Estimate: \$30,000 - \$40,000



Lot 35: Louis Vuitton Laureate Angle Boots. These Louis Vuitton hiking boots are crafted from supple calf suede leather and the designer's classic monogram canvas. The chunky treaded rubber soles make these statement shoes perfect for urban days or countryside weekends.

Lot 05: Cathy Daley - Black Dress Figure

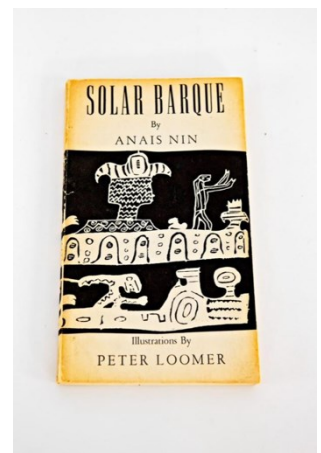
Cathy Daley's exploration of the "feminine" and movement is communicated through strong swifts of black oil pastel on vellum. The rubbed haze of the pastel communicates a lively aura and makes one feel that they are visualizing an expression in action, whether that be a shift of the hips or a swish of the hem. A Canadian icon, Cathy Daley was born in Toronto, Canada, in 1955 and passed away in 2022. She has permanent collections in the National Gallery of Canada, The Art Gallery of Ontario, and has had exhibitions worldwide. Estimate: \$800 - \$1,000



Lot 54: Anaïs Nin, *A Child Born out of the Fog*, Signed edition. A thin card, First Edition of *A Child Born out of the Fog*, published by Gemor Press, dated 1947. Nin and her husband moved to New York during WWII, Nin struggled to have her work published due to censorship and lack of interest in European authors, not to mention female authors.
Estimate: \$75 - \$150

Lot 58: Anaïs Nin, *Solar Barque*, Signed edition.

First Printing softcover, published in 1958 by Edwards Brothers, signed and inscribed on free front endpaper by author Anaïs Nin. Very good in illustrated covers; toning and light rubbing to cover edges.
Estimate: \$100 - \$200
